"The swimming club lost its source of income and was going to close after more than 40 years when Norman, then a volunteer lifeguard for the club, worked almost single-handedly and drummed up support from members to raise funds for the club and keep it going. Over the last 2 years he has made the club a registered charity and kept it going as a fundamental activity for many disabled people in Bexley. Any disabled person in Bexley is welcome to come and join the swimming sessions every Friday and to bring their family and friends along. This provides a physical activity and an opportunity for families to socialise and relax together."
